



Family Excavation Day June 13 and August 8, 2009



Is your child fascinated by ancient civilizations? Why not give them the opportunity to learn about prehistoric Native Americans and archeology in our region? The CAA's Family Excavation Day is the perfect solution. We combine an introduction to archeological excavation (we work at our 2000 year old village site) with an exploration of stone tool making, games, and much more. Join us for a fun **day** program full of discovery!

Program Details: The program runs from 10:00 am to 3:00 pm on Saturday, June 13. Tuition is \$40 per person (child or adult), and covers supplies and instruction. Food is not included in the program, so bring your own picnic lunch or dine at a local restaurant (list will be provided upon arrival). You'll also get a one-year membership in the CAA!

Who May Enroll: Children ages 7-12 and their parents/guardians/grandparents etc.

Is This Program Right For Us?: If your children are interested in archeology (remember, we don't study dinosaurs – that's paleontology, which is also really cool!), are able to listen to and take direction from CAA staff, and are able to handle the physical aspects of excavation (troweling, screening, a bit of shoveling), then they will most likely enjoy their experience. As much as we enjoy working with children under the age of 7, they are probably not quite ready for this program.

Enrollment Process: Complete the Registration Form and return it to the CAA Office along with your 30% deposit or full payment. Upon receipt of a completed Registration Form, we will send you a confirmation letter and a packet of additional information. ***Please note that your remaining tuition balance is due one week before the program begins.***

What Forms Do I Need to Complete?: Registration Form (one per family), and Assumption of Risk/Permission to Photograph Form (one per family). These are available in PDF format from the "Registration Packet" link on our main page.

NOTE: Registration for the program closes one week prior to the start of each session. Register early to reserve a space for your family—ENROLLMENT IS LIMITED TO 18 INDIVIDUALS.
