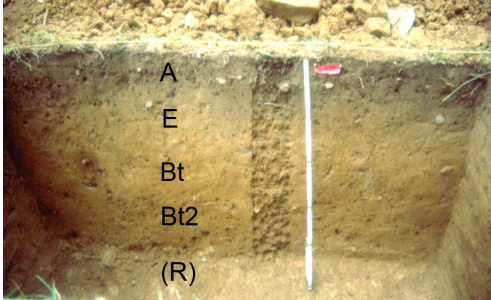




## GEOARCHEOLOGY WORKSHOP WITH DR. GREGORY VOGEL August 15-16, 2009



The CAA is pleased to offer two weekend hands-on geoaerchology workshops in 2009. Dr. Gregory Vogel, a Postdoctoral Research Associate at Arizona State University and Research Director at the Center, will lead these courses. Each workshop is an intensive, 2-day program appropriate for undergraduates, graduate students, and professional archeologists seeking to further their understanding of geoaerchology. Instruction will include informal lectures and hands-on experience describing, sampling, and interpreting soils and sediments in the field and in the laboratory. Special attention will be given to using soil and sediment data to

better interpret the archeological record.

Dr. Vogel, who obtained his Ph.D. from the University of Arkansas, is the author of “A Handbook of Soil Description for Archeologists.” For more information about Dr. Vogel, please visit:

**Program Details:** Tuition is \$200 for the weekend, and includes room, basic field lunch (sandwiches, chips, etc.) each day, and instruction. You’ll also get a one-year membership in the CAA!

A course syllabus will be provided upon your arrival. ***Please note that your remaining tuition balance is due one week before the program begins.***
